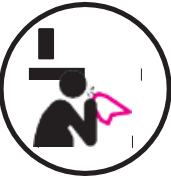


Guidance for pupils who have been asked to self-isolate

We've been notified that a pupil or member of staff in your child's bubble has tested positive for coronavirus. This means we must send your child and their bubble home from school. Please follow the guidance below.



Your child must self-isolate for 14 days. This starts from when your child was last in contact with the positive case (it can take up to 14 days for symptoms to appear).

Your child must not leave your home (unless in exceptional circumstances eg an emergency)

You must not have visitors in your home (for exceptions see www.gov.uk).

.....



Your child must not go out to public spaces to exercise - any exercise must take place at home or in your garden.

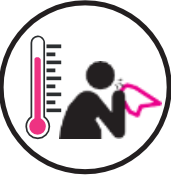
Encourage your child to wash their hands regularly.

Other people in your household do not need to self-isolate if your child does not have symptoms of coronavirus within the 14 day self-isolation period.
