

## SUBJECT OVERVIEW R.E.

BRIDGEWATER PRIMARY SCHOOL



At Bridgewater we aim to offer the children a wide, enriching and varied experience of the curriculum for R.E. We explore religions through looking at festivals, themes, places of Worship, having visitors into school amongst others. To support our Curriculum, we use the Discovery RE Scheme of Work as it adopts an enquiry-based approach to teaching and learning. Christianity is taught in every year group, with Christmas and Easter given new treatment each year, developing the learning in a progressive way. Hinduism, Islam, Judaism and Sikhism are also covered.

The overview grid shows the long-term plan for the coverage in each year group. Through this enquiry approach, we are able to provide opportunities for coverage of our PSHCE curriculum and development of the children's Spiritual, Moral, Social and Cultural understanding. Through the use of Mindfulness, we can build children's self-awareness and skills of reflection, thus supporting their RE learning as well as their personal spiritual development.

Our belief is that, using an enquiry-based model well, children's critical thinking skills can be developed, their motivation to learn increased, and their knowledge and understanding of, and empathy with people and their beliefs, religious or otherwise, will be enhanced.
