A warm welcome back to all our families

Promoting strong attendance

One of our key focus areas at Bridgewater this year is to improve school attendance as last year we did not reach our target of 96% across the whole school. We have seen an improvement this year and I am pleased to confirm that we are moving closer to **our 96% target and whole school attendance was 95.5% by the end of Summer 1** (this does not include Nursery and some Reception children who are not of Statutory School Age).

We have had a number of instances where school have not been informed of the reason as to a child's absence and despite our efforts we have not been able to contact parents to confirm why their child is not in school. This has resulted in school staff having to make a home visit. Please can I politely remind all parents to contact school **EACH** day of their child's absence to ensure the register can be updated accordingly and we are following our safeguarding duties.

We also have some children who are persistently absent (falling below 90%) missing out on important aspects of their education. These cases are closely monitored and managed by our Education Welfare Officer Jo Lindsay. We do our upmost to support families to improve attendance and ask that you speak to us directly if there are any reasons as to why your child is not attending school regularly. If parents do not engage with this process, fines and court proceedings may follow.

Sports Day

We will continue to encourage competitive sport with our annual Sports Day. The children will take part in good old-fashioned events, such as the egg and spoon race and obstacle race, but will also try the sports of javelin, long

End of Year Reports

End of year reports will be sent out to all parents in July. Parents will also be given the opportunity to discuss this report with your child's class teacher during an arranged parent-teacher meeting.

Children's University

This half-term, children who have collected enough Children's University credits/hours for attending after-school activities or other accredited Children's University Clubs, will be attending Salford University for their Children's University graduation - this will be in the morning of the 2nd July. We are so excited to attend our eighth graduation and celebrate the achievements of the children. Invitations to the event will be arriving home to the children who have collected sufficient hours this academic year. Children who have not collected enough hours should not be disappointed, as all hours are carried onto the following year.

Transition to new class September 2025

To help the children make a smooth transition to their new class we will host a day where the children get the opportunity to meet their new teacher and discuss class rules and routines ready for September. We hope this helps to alleviate any anxiety children may feel over the summer about starting a new class. We will let you and the children know who will be teaching each year group later in the term.
