#### **Promoting strong attendance**

One of our key focus areas at Bridgewater is to continue to promote strong school attendance.

## Currently, our whole school attendance is 95.4%- a great start which we hope to improve upon as we aim for 96%!

In instances where your child is unable to attend school, for example due to illness, please ensure you have informed the school office by 9:00am each day. We will continue to monitor every child's attendance and ask that parents fully encourage strong school attendance.

Attendance letters will once again be sent out later this half term which will clearly highlight whether your child's attendance is great and above 96% – green; needs improvement as is below 96% - amber or a cause for concern below 90% – red.

#### Parent/Teacher consultations

We will be holding Parent/Teacher consultations this half term to discuss with parents how your child has settled into their new class and how you can support their learning at home. A letter was sent out just before half term so please ensure you made an appointment with your child's class teacher. As always, you can also book an appointment with Miss Hopkins (Learning Mentor/Family Support) or Mrs Cope (SENCO) should you wish – please indicate this on your return slip.

#### **Behaviour Policy**

As discussed at our last Parent Forum, our updated behaviour policy will be available on our website later this term. We would like to acknowledge that without your commitment to this policy, we would not be fortunate enough to have such good behaviour standards and we are grateful that you continue to promote our school rules with your children at home.

#### **Communication with school**

Can I remind parents that if you wish to discuss your children's personal or academic development at any time throughout the school year to please see your child's class teacher and they will arrange a convenient time with you.

#### **Breakfast Club**

Our breakfast club was initially set up in 2015 in partnership with Greggs - who continue to fund the provision. The main focus of The Greggs Foundation is to give pupils the opportunity of accessing a healthy, nutritious breakfast free of charge to ensure they start their morning on the right track. We are able to offer 40 places to pupils who would benefit from a free meal. We operate a booking system rather than a walk-in system to ensure staff ratios are accurate. We do understand that this is not ideal for some of our working parents, as they need to secure permanent wrap around care to fit in with their working pattern. Please visit the Childcare Choices website to find out more information about wraparound care (www.childcarechoices.gov.uk). Our breakfast club places fill up quickly, so if you weren't able to secure a place for this half term when they first went live, please keep checking ParentPay as places do open up if we receive cancellations. We will be releasing places for next half term before we finish for Christmas and will send further communication regarding this later this term.

#### **Evolve (School Meals)**

Please remember to order your child's school dinner on Evolve each week. If you do not order your child's meal, they will be given a default meal. You may of course bring a packed lunch if preferred. Please remember to cancel the meal before 9.30am if your child is absent and speak with the office staff if you are having any issues with Evolve.

As we start the second half term, it may not surprise you that Christmas is just over 7 weeks away! We love this time of year at school and plan to have lots of exciting events for the children including pantos, parties and performances. Please take note of the dates on the calendar attached.
