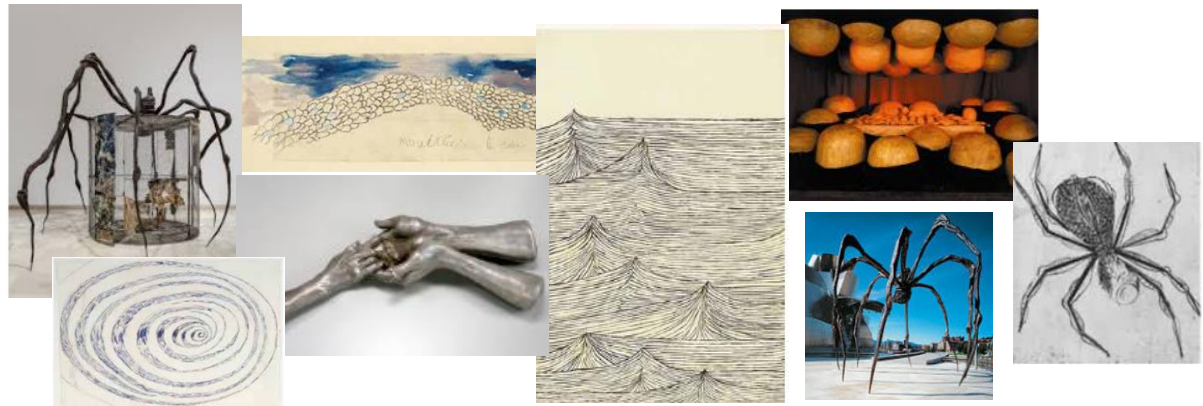

| Stitch |  | A loop of thread or yarn. |
| Sewing |  | Making or mending clothes using a needle and a stitch. |
| Assemble |  | Fit together different parts. |
| Dough |  | A mixture used for sculpting and making items. |
| Press |  | Apply pressure to something in order for it to flatten, shape or smooth it. |
| Build |  | To construct pieces and place them together. |
