Astronaut	A person who travels into space.

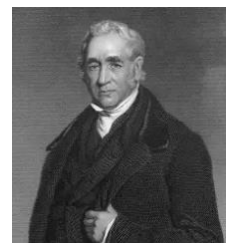
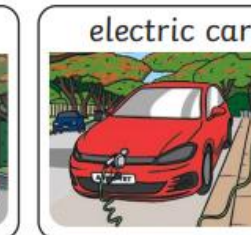
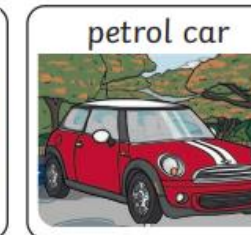
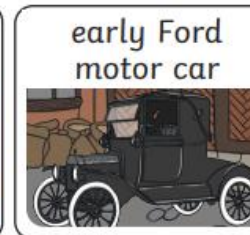
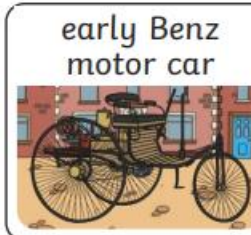
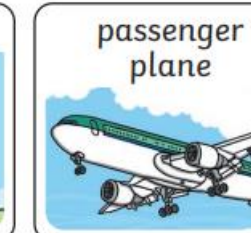
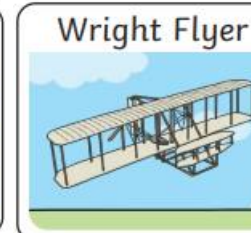
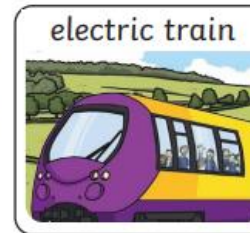
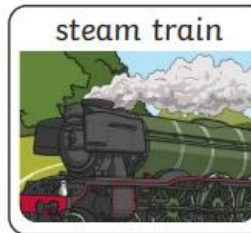
Key Knowledge
