

Year 4 Autumn Newsletter

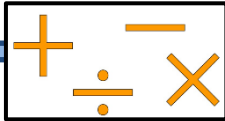
Welcome to Year 4! We hope you have enjoyed the summer holiday and look forward to getting to know you and your child over the next few weeks.

Maths:



In Maths we will be focusing on the 4 operations and our understanding of place value. We will practise the different method for adding, subtracting, multiplying and dividing. There will also be a big focus on learning our times tables as there is a multiplication check test near the end of Year 4. 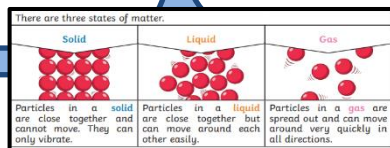
Science:

We will be testing various items to see whether the reaction is reversible or irreversible, we will be planning our own experiments to see if we can turn liquids into gases and separating groups of materials based on their properties. Reading:

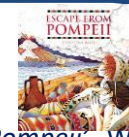
Reading continues to be of great importance. Reading every night to an adult can really help your child progress. Please encourage your child to read whenever possible and sign their Reading Records at least four times a week.
