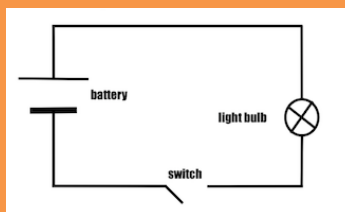


Axis powers
